

Ivan Bulić Foundation, Zagreb, Bani 100, VAT: 93635393694, represented by the Foundation Manager, Vladimir Bulić (hereinafter: the **Foundation**), on one side, and _____ (Name and Surname), Address, ID Number/OIB, student of the Faculty of Food Technology and Biotechnology in Zagreb (hereinafter: the Student), on the other side, on __.__. conclude the following

SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT

Clause 1

The Contracting Parties define the following:

- Based on Clauses 30, 31 and 33 of the Statute and Clause 14 of the Regulations on the criteria and procedure for granting awards, acknowledgments, supports and scholarships of Ivan Bulić Foundation (hereinafter: Regulations), the Foundation Board, as per Board's decision on September 9th, 2017, issued a Decree on awarding scholarships, acknowledgments, rewards and supports to best students, their projects and works. All Terms and Conditions from the Statute and Regulations apply.
- The Expert Committee has compiled a report on possible candidates, according to the clauses from the Statute and the Regulations, and based on the results of students' work and their projects
- After reviewing all candidates, the Expert Committee, including:
Prof. Dr. Sc. Branka Levaj, the President
Prof. Dr. Sc. Duška Ćurić, the Vice-president
Prof. Dr. Sc. Damir Stanzer,
Dr. Sc. Marija Carić,
Prof. Dr. Sc. Draženka Komes,
Suggested to the Foundation Board to award the scholarship to the Student

Clause 2

Expert Committee's suggestion was reviewed at the meeting of the Foundation Board on __.__. .

The Foundation Board accepted the suggestion of the Expert Committee and decided to award the scholarship to the Student.

Clause 3

The Contracting Parties agree that, based on this Contract, the Student will receive an amount of EUR 2.000,00 (two thousand euro) as a scholarship from the Foundation, divided into installments of EUR 166,67 (one hundred sixty six euro and sixty seven cents) during a maximum period of 12 months or until the end of the Student's studies.

Student can use the awarded scholarship as he/she pleases. Scholarship instalments will be deposited on a monthly basis into the following account:

Clause 4

Scholarship awarded from Clause 3 of this Contract represents support for education and professional development and is granted for the duration of the _/_ academic year.

In case that in the mentioned period Student abandons or finishes his/her studies, he/she is obliged to notify the Foundation with a written statement.

Clause 5

If, for any reason, a tax obligation is determined for this scholarship, the Student irrevocably accepts the obligation to pay such tax.

Clause 6

The Student accepts the obligation to accept employment at one or more of the interested Foundation Members or Contractual Supporters upon finishing his/her studies for a period of at least the same number of months for which the scholarship had been received from the Foundation.

The Student will be notified of his/her employment by the Foundation Member(s) or Contractual Supporter(s), based on the written Statement of Interest of the interested parties. Such notice will be delivered to the Student's registered address.

The Foundation may inform the Student of Foundation Members and/or Contractual Supporters showing interest and possibility of employment before his/her graduation.

Clause 7

By fulfilling the obligation from Paragraph 1, Clause 6 of this Contract, the Student is relieved of the scholarship reimbursement obligation to the Foundation.

Clause 8

After receiving any kind of support from the Foundation, the Student accepts the obligation of actively participating in the Foundation's Council and contributing to the

realization of ideas, purposes and goals of the Foundation through his/her knowledge and experience.

Clause 9

As the Student has already proven his/her excellence by being awarded the scholarship, he/she has an option to reject employment offered by the Foundation Member(s) and/or Contractual Supporter(s) in case the terms of employment offered and average monthly income are not above the average of the income of experts-beginners in the food industry for bakery, pastry and confectionery.

Clause 10

If the Student receives an employment offer from several Foundation Members or Contractual Supporters, he/she has the option to choose the employer and notify the Foundation of his/her choice.

The Foundation then informs its Members, as well as Contractual Supporters about the Student's employment choice.

Clause 11

If within three months of his/her written statement to the Foundation regarding finishing his/her studies the Student does not receive a written Statement of Interest by any of the Foundation Members or Contractual Supporters, the Student is relieved of his/her employment obligations with the Foundation Members and Contractual Supporters, as well as the refund of the scholarship.

Clause 12

If the Student, without any justified reason, refuses employment offered by a Foundation Member or Contractual Supporter and does not properly fulfil his/her obligations from Clauses 1 and 6 of this Contract, he/she is obliged to return the full amount of the scholarship into the Foundation's account in the same instalments and on monthly basis, as he/she received it.

Clause 13

Student has the right to apply for the Foundation's Tender every year, equally with all other candidates, and apply for scholarships described in the Tender based on his/her achievements.

Clause 14

In case of any misunderstandings, both Contracting Parties are committed to resolve them in a peaceful manner. If, however, such agreement is not possible, they will contract the jurisdiction of the according court in Zagreb.

Clause 15

Contracting Parties agree on the Contract coming into effect on the day it is signed by both Parties.

Clause 16

This Contract is made in two (2) identical copies, of which each Contracting Party holds one (1) copy.
